



Greenwich Library Policy
Access
Approved November 12, 2019

The Library shall maintain access to its resources, subject to Library policies, and constraints such as funding, staffing, the availability of space, and demand for particular resources.

1. Library Access:

The Library shall permit use of materials and services in the Library as well as attempt to provide remote access to those users incapable of physically accessing these resources.

The Library endorses and subscribes to the American Library Association (“ALA”) Policy regarding the provision of equitable access for persons with disabilities.

Charges for special services may be imposed by the Board. A schedule of charges shall be made available to the public.

2. Borrowing Privileges:

A Library card may be acquired without fee for those who live, work, own property, or attend school in Greenwich. Others may acquire a Library card for an annual fee.

Holders of cards from other public Connecticut libraries may borrow physical materials, subject to limitations imposed by the Library staff from time to time
